

SENATOR FELLMAN: I move the bill be returned to Select File for specific amendment.

PRESIDENT: Right, and that amendment would be...

SENATOR FELLMAN: To allow a cash contribution up to I think the paper there says \$50.00. Or to phrase it to reverse....'

CLERK: Read amendment.

SENATOR FELLMAN: OK...

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the amendment? Question is do you want to return the bill in order to consider the amendment. All those in favor of the return on LB614 vote aye, those opposed vote no. You are returning the bill only. Thank you. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 1 nay on the motion to return.

PRESIDENT: Bill is returned. Senator Fellman.

SENATOR FELLMAN: I move the adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT: OK, is there any need for further discussion? Senator Proud, do you want to be heard on the amendment?

SENATOR PROUD: Mr. President, a question of Senator Fellman.

SENATOR FELLMAN: Yield.

SENATOR PROUD: When your amendment says "cash" is that right? You refer to cash, now, do we have any problem here at all as a distinction between cash and currency, what I am thinking is or maybe you have made it perfectly clear, but for example, when you buy something in a store, they may say cash or credit card, and they assume that I believe that a check is cash, so are we clear on this point?

SENATOR FELLMAN: I think that the bill....I don't have the bill in front of me, but I think that the bill itself makes that distinction. This is an exception, it talks about checks. It talks in another section about checks, is that correct?

SENATOR PROUD: I just didn't want to get hung up on the word cash here.

SENATOR FELLMAN: I think that it is in the bill.

SENATOR PROUD: If that is clear then it is OK.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion? Question is do you want to adopt the amendment? If you are in favor of the amendment as proposed by Senator Fellman, vote aye, if not vote no. Voting on Senator Fellman's amendment 614 on Select File. Thank you. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 1 nay and 20 not voting.

PRESIDENT: Very good, the amendment is adopted. Senator Stull.

SENATOR STULL: (mike not activated) E & R as amended.
