

SENATOR STULL: I move that 755 be advanced as amended.

PRESIDENT: You heard the motion to advance the bill as amended. All those in favor of the advancement please say aye, those opposed say no. So ordered. 755 is advanced.

SENATOR STULL: I move the E & P amendments to 782 be adopted.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to adopt the amendments to 782. All those in favor of that motion say aye, those opposed say no. Amendments are adopted.

SENATOR STULL: I move...

CLERK: Mr. President, there is an amendment by Senator Fellman, read amendment.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Fellman.

SENATOR FELLMAN: Mr. President, this is an attempt to clear up a misunderstanding in the bill to separate the board of corrections department from the Sheriffs Office in Douglas County. This leaves the Sheriff with jurisdiction for the first 48 hours. I move the adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion? Question is do you want to adopt the amendment to 782 on Select File. All those in favor of the Fellman amendment vote aye, those opposed vote no. Voting on the adoption of the Fellman amendment of 782. Thank you. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes.

PRESIDENT: Amendment is adopted.

SENATOR STULL: I move that 782 be advanced to E & R as amended.

PRESIDENT: You heard the motion to advance LB782 as amended. All those in favor of the advancement of the bill say aye, those opposed say no. So ordered. The bill as amended is advanced. Thank you. PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Warner.

It is another one of these examples that give a bad name to legislature and an amendment that is at least highly significant to a lot of people, was put on without public hearing.
