

SENATOR MARVEL: Does somebody have a question?

PRESIDENT: Does somebody have a question? Yes, wait a minute Senator Kremer does.

CLERK: LB997....

SENATOR MARVEL: You don't need me on the amendments for the bill because 997 is acted upon by the appropriations committee. We made our recommendations as we do in every other bill. It is now the property of the legislature, once the legislature makes up its mind on amendments, then it will be advanced. Tomorrow morning at 8:00 the Appropriations Committee will have a meeting to consider two other budget bills. One reason that we haven't come in before is that the computers at the University broke down, and we have no control over mechanical operations even if the mechanics are extensive. But, let me specific. As far as members of the appropriation committee are concerned, this bill is the property of the legislature. We made our recommendations and if you want me to respond to a specific question, I'll be glad to otherwise I would assume that the legislature is about ready to advance that bill to E & R initial. After I answer the question I would respectfully request that Senator Whitney proceed with whatever questions may come up.

CLERK: Read

SENATOR MARVEL: Now would you like to have me respond to a question.

SENATOR KREMER: Senator Marvel, my only question was that because there are three bills at the head of General File for discussion today, at the head of general file, my question to the chair a little while ago was only....and this was my question which has priority, the unfinished business with respect to 997 or the three bills at the head of general file. Now all three of those bills will evidently generate quite a lot of debate, and I personally feel that not only for the personal interest that I have in it but we ought to move on 997.

PRESIDENT: According to the adgenda unfinished business which this bills fall into that category would receive prior attention to the three bills and I would so rule, and that is were we are, and that is what he is attempting to do. Senator Kremer, can you go ahead. I think Senator Marvel we would like to have you stand by while Senator Kremer makes his motion here for the amendment to the bill in order to be able to handle or answer specific questions.

CLERK: Read

PRESIDENT: Alright, motion is to withdraw that particular amendment. It hasn't been debated yet, are there objections to withdrawing that particular amendment?

SENATOR KREMER: Mr. President, may I state my reasons for this request.

PRESIDENT: Yes, go ahead.
