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jeopardize another program, might cause serious problems. Now, we have an understanding including Senator Simpson who is vitally concerned with this, Senator Kennedy and myself and some others, that we think we can ferret out adequate information to make a determination as to what direction we can go and still not jeopardize the mental health hospital. And the proposal that we've kind of agreed upon in order to achieve this without damaging either the mental health clinic or the proposed program is to bracket the bill until such time as we get adequate information. Those of us who are so concerned and can convey it to you and resolve the problem at that time. So in an unusual motion, I guess, I'm asking to withdraw the motion to refer it to committee and put the substitute motion that it shall be bracketed indefinitely on General File and rest assured, I have Senator Kennedy's promise, I have Senator Simpson's agreement, we will make sure we act wisely and get all proper information to you. So, I ask unanimous consent to withdraw the first motion and to put the substitute motion of indefinitely bracketing it on General File.

PRESIDENT: Now, are there objections to the withdrawal of his motion that LB1052 be referred to committee for hearing? Are there any objections to the withdrawal of that motion? Does the Chair hear any objections? Senator Kennedy, do you object to the withdrawal? Senator Kennedy, the question is do you object to the withdrawal of his motion?

SENATOR KENNEDY: No.

PRESIDENT: Thank you. All right then, that motion is withdrawn and the issue before the Body then is to indefinitely bracket on General File LB1052. That's the issue now before the Body. Senator Kennedy, do you want to speak to that issue?

SENATOR KENNEDY: I think let's kind of get back to the original thoughts. You know where the bill is. It's the last bill on the General File. If all of you fellows think we're going to get through all of those bills, now I'm trying to make a very sincere effort.....
