

PRESIDENT: Senator Whitney is looking for 25 votes on his amendment....25 votes for an amendment to LB1003 on Select File. Have you all voted?

SENATOR WHITNEY: Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Stand by, it's coming. Okay, Clerk will record. Read the tally.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: I move LB1003 as amended be advanced to E & R for Engrossing.
