PRESIDENT: Clerk will clear the board.

PRESIDENT: Just a minute. You all understand the motion. The question is, shall LB963 be placed on General File notwithstanding the action of the Committee. All right.

CLERK: Voting aye 27, noting no, 18, not voting 4. (Printed on pages 1149-50 of Journal)

PRESIDENT: Could we have a little order in here. I've now rapped the gavel twice, just fairly recently. The Clerk can barely hear your response. Just a minute, Senator Nore for what purpose do you rise.

SENATOR NORE: I would like to know Mr. President, and fellow members why the Health...Health and Wel...Public Health Committee turned this bill down. We have had no discussion on this. We are voting in the dark.

PRESIDENT: Well, Senator Carpenter had made the motion, and I asked if you were all through discussing the bill, and there was no response at that time, I presume the Chair has done everything that we can at this particular time. I don't think I should suspend the Roll Call vote on this, to suspend the rules at this time. There is a Roll Call vote on this. All right, Senator....

CLERK: 27 ayes, 18 nays, 4 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries LB963 is placed on General File notwithstanding the action-of the committee. Now, Senator Nore your light is still on. Did you want to ask a question. All right, thank you Sir. What other motions now, do we have on the desk? Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: Mr. President, I think probably an explanation of 963, now on General File should be given as to whether or not it comes on General File in it's original form, or without any committee amendments at all. Because I'll tell you for sure if you think you have had anything yet, wait until this happens.
