SENATOR MARSH: Williams Jennings Bryan, Oh Boy.

PRESIDENT: Thank you.

CLERK: Mr. President I move to withdraw LB880 (Signed) Senator Kelly. And as a part of the same motion replace in it's position on General File LB754 (Signed) Senator Kelly.

PRESIDENT: Speaker Proud.

SPEAKER PROUD: What's the...

PRESIDENT: Stand by, that's that we are discussing here just a moment. Well all right, stand by. Here is the motion Senator Proud, and that is that Senator Kelly is asking that he be allowed to withdraw LB880 and substitute in it's place on General File LB754. And I can understand that actually it takes 25 votes to withdraw the bills, so I'm going to presume that the same 25 votes would let him...would be authority for him to place that in it's place on General File.

SENATOR PROUD: Is this one of his preferred bills, or not.

PRESIDENT: I can't answer that.

SENATOR PROUD: I'll ask Senator Kelly.

PRESIDENT: Senator Kelly. Stand by, Senator Syas, Just a minute. We've got a discussion going on here.

SENATOR PROUD: Senator Kelly what I'm getting at. Is this deal with one of your preferred bills that you have already marked.

SENATOR KELLY No, it does not, Speaker Proud, the situation here is that LB880 was given to me by the Vehicles....

PRESIDENT: Could we please have some order in the chamber.

SENATOR KELLY ....To bring their rules and regulations up-to-date. Now they also gave an almost identical bill to Senator Carpenter at their meeting last week they determined that they wanted LB754 instead of 880. I see these two bills as the same thing and would withdraw the 880 and allow 754 to stand in it's place. It isn't a matter that it's my priority at all it's fair to the Vehicle Licensing Board that their bills stand in that place.

SENATOR PROUD: Well, then as I understand you, you want to move LB754. You want to advance it on the General File list is that correct. Forget about 880 for a minute. I want to know what you want to do about 754.

PRESIDENT: He wants to put it in 880's place on General File. I think.

SENATOR KELLY: Yes, 880 is worked it's way all of these months up pretty close to the top, and 754 is coming along behind it some distance. They are the same subjects, they do the same job. We just wanted to withdraw 880 and put 754 in it's place on General File.

SPEAKER PROUD: Now, are you telling me that they do the same thing. In affect the same bill?
