PRESIDENT: You do not want to yield the floor?

SENATOR KEYES: I do not want to yield to Senator Burbach right now.

PRESIDENT: Fine. Go ahead. Senator Keyes has the floor. Senator Burbach stand by. Now, I'm going to remind the body that the question before the body at this time, and the only question before the body at this time is shall LB1028 be bracketed on Select File. You can discuss the bill someother time, but the question before now is, shall it be bracketed. If you are going to bracket it, that's yes or no. Then we will discuss it, if it is not bracketed. And if you want to go ahead and discuss it. NOW, Senator Keyes. Thank you, Sir. Go ahead.

SENATOR KEYES: Mr. President, I'm going to speak directly to Senator Cavanaugh. Why he wants to bracket it, and what's going to be the repercussions if he does bracket the bill.

I'm surprised that the people that back me, and that's the Labor Union don't realize what this might do to them. I haven't heard a word from them, but I'll guarantee you, that if it's there for 4 daays, I'll probably hear from them. I'm going to vote to support, and get this bill across because I think it's one of the finest things that we can do for this state. And investigate when there is corruption. If anybody is opposing this. Any corporation. And group of people, they are opposing it because they are just a little bit afraid. Senator Schmit, said the best thing a few minutes ago. He said, Orville, he says, you never drive about...never worry about being speeding. He says, I worry all the time because I am speeding. I try to stay under the speed limit. I don't worry about the patrol man. I don't worry about this bill because I try to do that which is right. But those people that are doing that which is wrong are scared to death of this bill.
