

fiscal impact from the state general funds. The fees paid in for the inspections and these will counterbalance the effect of the fiscal impact as indicated there.

PRESIDENT: Question is do you want to return LB826A for a specific amendment as outlined by Senator Burbach. This is the question to return the bill only. Those in favor of returning the bill vote aye, those opposed vote no. Motion to return LB826A for a specific amendment, on Select File Have you all voted? Thank you, Clerk will record.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays.

PRESIDENT: The bill is returned. Senator Burbach.

SENATOR BURBACH: Adopt the amendment I just gave and just gave the explanation for it.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the amendment? Senator Goodrich.

SENATOR GOODRICH: This involves a...a..I was involved in a conversation with Senator Fowler and frankly I didn't hear what the amendment was. Would you re-read it.

PRESIDENT: Read amendment.

CLERK: Read

PRESIDENT: Senator Goodrich.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Why don't we let Senator Burbach tell us what it is. I can't make heads or tails out of that.

PRESIDENT: Stand by.

SENATOR BURBACH: I realize Senator Goodrich that I did explain. The reason for the change in the amendment, the bill was amended and included the modular homes rather than the just mobile homes. This is an inspection fee paid by the manufacturer of the facility of the home, in the case of the mobile and module home, and this is no money from the state general fund but it is that increase due to the module homes. As I indicated, there is no General Fund money.

SENATOR GOODRICH: OK, no sweat.

PRESIDENT: Question is do you want to adopt the amendment to LB826A. All those in favor of adopting the amendment vote aye, those opposed vote no. You are voting on the adoption of the amendment. Have you all vote? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays.

PRESIDENT: Amendment is adopted. Senator Burbach what is your pleasure regarding the bill?

SENATOR BURBACH: I move to advance LB826A on to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT: You heard the motion to readvance the bill as amended. All those in favor of readvancing the bill please
