

SENATOR FOWLER: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, I would have to echo Senator Barnett's comments. These amendments were suggested to the committee, the committee chose not to accept them a these amendments were presented for the whole body on Select File and again it was chosen not to accept these unless some sort of compelling reasons were presented, and none were presented to me. I see no need to come back and reconsider this issue for a third time. I think it has been covered very thoroughly by both the committee and the body and there is no need to bring it back.

PRESIDENT: Stand by, we have a malfunction here and the Chair assumes the responsibility for this 995 is already on Select File and it is a out of order to consider a specific amendment at this time unless the bill is readvanced and then brought back for that. That is the Chair's fault and I apologize for that. We didn't quite catch it that that bill is sitting on Select File at this time. Now, Senator Barnett, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR BARNETT: Can I advance it so we can take care of it? I have another thing that I would like to do if I can advance it because it was on E & R Engrossing and it would come back for a technical amendment which nobody can do anything about until we advance it, so I would like to move for the advancement and I'm a...a...for 995 if I'm not out of order.

PRESIDENT: Why don't you stand by and lets advance our list here. We have to go through the list then if you want to come back for something specific I'll...

SENATOR BARNETT: I want to give Senator Lewis every opportunity, I just don't want to cut him off at the pass.

PRESIDENT: That is OK, thank you. What do we have now on Select File?

CLERK: Read motion regarding 957.

PRESIDENT: Senator Fellman in the chamber. We are ready to unbracket your motion to unbracket 957. Unanimous consent request. Senator Fellman.

SENATOR FELLMAN: This is the bill that puts the a...a...together the revocation of a drivers license and a guy that doesn't pay child support. The motion to unbracket is accompanied by a motion to kill based on the Attorney Generals opinion which has now been received.

PRESIDENT: I'm not sure I know what I heard.

SENATOR FELLMAN: I'm not sure where we stand....I thought that I was moving...

PRESIDENT: Motion is to unbracket the bill. We have to unbracket it first then we can consider the bill.

SENATOR FELLMAN: OK, I move the bill be unbracketed.

PRESIDENT: Senator Fellman is asking unanimous consent under his motion to unbracket 957 on Select File. Are there any objections to unbracketing 957 on Select File? Any objections? Hearing none, so ordered, the bill is unbracketed.
