

lets bring it back and amend it and get some controls in there so that you know that we are not going over board. I think that the whole thing should be eliminated but if it is brought back I would be receptive on at least getting on reasonable amendments.

PRESIDENT: Question is do you want to reconsider your action on LB972 and return the bill to Final Reading. All those... Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DE CAMP: In the four years I have asked for a roll call vote once, today is the second time because I think that three or four years hence, if this bill passes there are going to be people in here that will be standing up and supporting the thing today like they did on meat inspections and some of these other federal programs, ahhhh....we made a mistake and lets solve it, so I want a roll call vote.

PRESIDENT: Fine, Senator DeCamp has asked for a roll call vote. Clerk will being the roll call.

CLERK: Roll call vote. 15 ayes, 30 nays and 4 not voting. Vote appears on page 1190 of the Legislative Journal.

PRESIDENT: Motion to return the bill and reconsider the action is lost.

CLERK: Read committee on committee report

CLERK: Read Judiciary Committee report. Read Government report.

PRESIDENT: We have a motion on the desk.

CLERK: For what? I have several. Read Marvel motion.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: This is the last bill and this is the deficiency appropriation bill.

PRESIDENT: Is there need for further discussion of the motion? Question is shall the bill be introduced? All those in favor of the introduction of the bill vote aye, those opposed vote no. It takes 30 votes. Thank you, Clerk will record.

CLERK: 36 ayes.

PRESIDENT: Thank you, the bill is introduced.

CLERK: LB1059 read.

PRESIDENT: Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: I think that in one motion I can ask that the bill be put right behind 1058 on General File.
