CLERK: Read vote. (Found on pgs. 1205-06 of Journal).

PRESIDENT: And the total is?

CLERK: 42 ayes, 0 nays, 7 not voting.

PRESIDENT: Thank you, the bill is passed. Attention please, the Final Reading of LB1011. Clerk will read the bill.

CLERK: Read LB1011.

PRESIDENT: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? The Clerk will.....Senator Lewis, for what purpose do you rise? Senator Lewis, what....?

SENATOR F. LEWIS: Okay, I'm sorry.

PRESIDENT: I want you to stand by and wait till we finish this one if you don't mind. All right, read the....the Clerk will record.

CLERK: Read vote. (Found on page 1206 of Journal).

PRESIDENT: And the totals are?

CLERK: 44 ayes, 0 nays, 5 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The bill is passed. Now, Senator Lewis, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR F. LEWIS: Mr. Chairman, on LB1024, I ask that that be moved back to Select File for a specific amendment. The amendment simply provides that the mayor may appoint particular officers with the approval of the Council and now the League of Municipalities and others have asked us to insert what we inadvertently dropped out that when the mayor is removing appointed officers, it's also with the approval of the Council. Just an oversight on the committee what needed to be done.

PRESIDENT: Do we have a copy of the amendment up here, Senator Lewis.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: Yes.

PRESIDENT: Do we have a copy of the amendment up here? Stand by. Are you all through discussing the motion to return the bill? Anybody want to discuss it? Question is then, Senator Syas, the motion is just to return the bill. We're not arguing the amendment.

SENATOR SYAS: Here we go again.

PRESIDENT: That's right.

SENATOR SYAS: I'd like to ask Senator...as I get it, your amendment is that the mayor of a town can't remove a fellow, his own appointee, without the consent of the Council? Is that right?
