

Read Government and Military Affairs report.

RPRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Schmit for his motion on LB1028.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, I was visiting with Senator Proud, could you tell me where we are at right now? I move to returned the bill for a specific amendment.

PRESIDENT: That is correct sir.

SENATOR SCHMIT: I so move. I think that we have had enough discussion. I have a memo which is on your desk, the amendment provides that the person who is subponeaed to testify is granted immunity. According to committee council, Mr. Gillmore, we need to provide this or we may have, and I don't like to lean on the damn thing cause I have wiggled out of that a couple of times and that is the constitutional problem of the bill. That is why I am asking that we return the bill.

PRESIDENT: Do we need to discuss the motion any more? Question is shall LB1028 be returned to Select File for specific amendment as outlined by Senator Schmit. This bill or this vote is to return the bill only. All those in favor of returning the bill vote aye, those opposed vote no. This motion is to return LB1028, return it only. Then we will take up the Schmit Specific amendment. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 2 nays.

PRESIDENT: Now debate the Schmit amendment, Senator Keyes for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR KEYES: Mr. Speaker is it possible to limit

PRESIDENT: No, my name is president.

SENATOR KEYES: Is it possible to limit the debate to five minutes or else a motion to adjourn is in order.

PRESIDENT: Pardon?

SENATOR KEYES: Is it possible to limit the debate to five minutes or a motion to adjourn will be in order?

PRESIDENT: Only a motion to adjourn, but if you want to limit to five minutes, that takes a suspension of the rules because the rules provide for ten minutes for each person.

SENATOR KEYES: If after five minutes we are still debating it I will make that motion.

PRESIDENT: Alright, thank you. Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: I don't need as much time as Senator Keyes. I move the amendment be adopted.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the motion? Alright the question is do you want to adopt the Schmit amendment? All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Thank you. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 1 nay.
