CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Luedtke has pending a motion to withdraw LB520. The motion was made yesterday. It's been laid over.

PRESIDENT: Senator Luedtke.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Mr. President, this bill was introduced last session...let's see, is that LB520? This was the bill that was requested by the Corporate Council of the City of Lincoln regarding licenses...automobile licenses to be turned in lieu of arrest. We already have passed an in lieu of arrest for misdemeanants and they're ready in lieu of arrest traffic citations, rules have been established by the Supreme Court to do it. It is absolutely unnecessary. We'd just like to have it withdrawn.

PRESIDENT: Any discussion of withdrawing LB920? If not, this will just simply take a simple majority. Takes a machine vote. Those in favor of withdrawing LB920, vote aye. Those opposed vote nay. If you are in favor of the withdrawal of the bill, vote aye. If not, vote no. Senator Luedtke is asking permission to withdraw the bill.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: It's LB520, be sure it's the right number. Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Excuse me, LB520 is the number, will the Clerk.....

SENATOR LUEDTKE: LB520, I believe, is the number, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: All right, let's try it once again.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: LB520 is the number.

PRESIDENT: Senator Luedtke is asking permission and if I can have your attention to withdraw LB520. Thank.....wait a minute. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 17 ayes, no nays.

PRESIDENT: The bill's withdrawn. Do we have other motions on the desk?

CLERK: Nothing further, Mr. President.
