SENATOR KELLY: Yes, it would certainly be agreeable with me and I think that it would be very appropriate if say, you pick out a \$10 figure or whatever would be reasonable that would cover, that we would want to cover and take them out of the contribution side, and take them out of the expense side. No objections whatsoever Senator.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion? Senator Fellman?

SENATOR FELLMAN: I would like to ask Senator Mahoney, or Senator Kelly if they don't think that this small thing ought to be raised even to \$25.00? So that it could cover a \$4, \$10, or \$15 items rather than just a dollar of five dollars? Or \$50, we use \$50 on the cash contribution. I don't know that any great deal of harm can.....I don't know if you could buy an election with \$50.

SENATOR KELLY: Senator Fellman, I must confess that I would be well aware of the fact that Senator Barnett would amend to \$50 but I thought that we would run a Chinese auction and start at \$10.

SENATOR FELLMAN: Would you be agreeable to \$50?

SENATOR KELLY: Yes sir I would be agreeable to anything that would get a standard reporting system so that candidates will know what to do and that the public would have an immediate audit available to prove just how darn hard these candidates do work and how open and fair we really are.

PRESIDENT: Senator Keyes, do you have a question?

SENATOR KEYES: I pass.

PRESIDENT: OK, do you have any further discussion of the motion? Alright Senator Marvel back to you. Senator Marvel is now closing on his motion is to reconsider the action of 677.

SENATOR MARVEL: I waive the closing Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The question is do you want to reconsider your action on....Senator Keyes....Pardon me sir? Senator Keyes just announced that corn is up 3½¢. Question is do you want to reconsider your action on LB677? If you do vote aye, if not vote no. The motion takes 25 votes. Have you all voted? Stand by, we will wait for you Senator Stahmer, take your time. OK, now have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 3 nays and 17 not voting.

PRESIDENT: Motion prevails.

CLERK: Read motion regarding 805 on Select a...a..E & R Final. Signed Senator Kremer.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Kremer.

SENATOR KREMER: Mr. President, I ask unanimous consent to unbracket 805. It was about a week ago that I asked that this bill be bracketed for a forth coming amendment that was suggested by the Department of Roads in agreement with the City of Lincoln. The amendment is on the Clerk's desk, if you would like to discuss it.
