CLERK: Mr. President your committee on Enrollment and Review reports that we have examined and reviewed LB861, 922, 131 and 805 be replaced on Select File
Mr. President, an Attorney General's opinion addressed to Senator Murphy will be inserted in the Journal

PRESIDENT: So ordered.

CLERK: Mr. President we have a communications from the Governor which has already been distributed to the membership. I wonder if I can just insert it in the Journal.

PRESIDENT: So ordered.

CLERK: Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Now, then. Senator Proud.

SENATOR PROUD: Well, Mr. President, I ask that the last bills we advanced be expedited with all possible haste so that we can get them right over to the Governor's office as quickly as possible.

PRESIDENT: Those have already been. WE had a motion the other day for..if I may have your attention. There was a motion adopted the other day which ex... All right, so ordered. The bill is expedited. The Chair seems to recollect that we had a motion and it did apply to all bills passed off of General File from that point on. Senator Richendifer.

SENATOR RICHENDIFER: Mr. President and members of the Legislature. I move that 997 be moved along with this bill. With this bill. So we can look at both of them across the board. Now, let's try to be fair about it.

PRESIDENT: Senator Richendifer, are you here or not?

SENATOR RICHENDIFER: Yes and no.

PRESIDENT: I just excused you.

SENATOR RICHENDIFER: I move to advance LB997.

PRESIDENT: Well stand by, we have to read the bill first here. All right the next order of business LB 977.

CLERK: OK. Mr. President I move to bracket 977 on General File (Signed) Senator Goodrich.

PRESIDENT: Senator Goodrich's motion was to bracket 977? All right. Senator Goodrich.

SENATOR GOODRICH: It's just that we don't dare take up this one and pass it too. So I suggest that we just bracket it and hold it there.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to bracket 977, then. Are there objections to bracketing the bill. Senator Kennedy.

SENATOR KENNEDY: Yes, I'd like to know the reason.

PRESIDENT: Senator Goodrich, do you want to explain the reason for bracketing the bill.
