SENATOR NORE: Am I correct in asking Senator Luedtke a question, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Yes, you are correct.

SENATOR NORE: Don't we have...some of those...

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Point of order. I don't believe you can...

PRESIDENT: If your question is on the position to close debate.

SENATOR NORE: Yes. O.K.

PRESIDENT: You will have to phrase it well.

SENATOR NORE: All I wanted to say, we do have some bills ....

PRESIDENT: Are you asking a question. Thank you, Senator Nore you made your point. All those in favor signify by voting aye. Yes this is on Senator Luedtke's motion to recess and then reconvene. I would rule that it takes 25 votes. Clerk will record the vote.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 13 nays.

PRESIDENT: Motion is carried.

CLERK: I ask unanimous consent to hear LB1049 on Wednesday, March 27 considered on General File that day. (Signed) Senator Maresh.

PRESIDENT: Senator Maresh are you asking unanimous consent to place that at the head of General File?

SENATOR MARESH: Let me explain.

PRESIDENT: I would rule this out..it would of necessity have to be a suspension of the rules.

SENATOR MARESH: O.K. The bill provides for payment of unpaid claims that were allowed by the Claims Board and by the Committee. And I think it is important, just as important as the Budget Bill that it be acted on this year, so...

PRESIDENT: May I make a suggestion to you. Would you please change your motion so that it follows the bills on...the Budget Bills, the appropriation bills.

SENATOR MARESH: O.K. Very good.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to suspend the rules and place the Claims bill at the bottom of the appropriation bills on General File. The Claims Bills. Is there any discussion. jJust a moment. Senator Goodrich.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Just a question for Senator Maresh. You only referred to 1049. There is 1049 and 1050, are they being combined or something or...

SENATOR MARESH: Senator Goodrich, 1050 was killed in committee so it would not be considered.
