So what we are proposing to do and I would suggest that those of you who are interested in this area double check with a...a..page 75 and the language in that which not only talks about an accounting system but also as you will find on page 75 and also on page 76 that and we brought in not only the Director of the Department of Administrative Services and the head of the fiscal administration but also the Director of Personnel to try and encourage them, and that is put in rather strong language in this bill that we have a personnel payroll system that means something. AT the moment it is almost impossible to tie the personnel system to any kind of payroll information. You are never going to have any control until you do. It states on page 76 on line 14 to provide monthly data on staffing, positions full time equivalence and go on down then through line 16 locations accurate wages, salaries, and reports and so on. Thsoe of you who are frustrated with the personnel system at the moment, personnel information I suggest that you take a look at that particular area.
