PRESIDENT: Senator Epke. Your light is still on, do you want to debate the issue. Question is then, do you want to adopt the committee amendments. Senator Carpenter do you have any further arguments on the committee amendments. All right. All those in favor of the adoption of the committee amendments say aye. Those opposed say no. Ayes have it. So ordered. The committee amendments are adopted. Are there other amendments to the bill. Senator Carpenter over to you. That we adopt the committee amendments.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I move the bill be advanced from General File to E & R Initial. With this understanding, we hold it on Select File until sometime the middle of next week. And that will give you gentlemen a time when you are home to contact any and every dealer you want to find out if they want it. If you find a general disposition on the part of the dealer structure not to buy, I don't want it either, and if it isn't so that they are going to pay all the dollars spent, I don't want it either, but that's as I understand the matter. I move the bill be moved over.

PRESIDENT: Now is there any further discussion of the bill. Then the question before the body is, shall LB754 be advanced from General File to E & R Initial as amended. All those in favor will vote aye, all those opposed vote no. Have you all voted. Voted on the movement of 754. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 31 ayes 1 nay and 7 not voting.

PRESIDENT: Bill is advanced. That brings up 754A.

CLERK: 754A Title read.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: I move the bill be advanced from General File to E & R with the understanding there is no tax money spent at all. It all comes out of the dealers fund from the standpoint of their dealers.

PRESIDENT: Is there a need to further discuss the bill. Then the motion is shall LB754A be advanced from General File to E & R Initial. All those in favor of the advancement of the bill will vote aye, all those opposed will vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, no nays.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced. That brings up for General File discussion LB757. Senator Dickinson's bill. Clerk will read the title.

CLERK: LB757 Title read. The committee amendments have been adopted. There is an amendment by Senator Barnett which has been adopted. There are pending amendments offered by Senator Cavanaugh which are found in page 856 of the Legislative Journal.

PRESIDENT: Page 856, Cavanaugh amendment. All right. Senator Cavanaugh back to you for your amendment.
