I have a 875A on general file and has it been our practice Mr. Speaker to bring the A bill up to Select File with the

SENATOR BARNETT: Mr. President, I have to have it clarified as to what Senator Snyder is intending to do because if we pass the bill on the way it is, without my amendment there is a conflict with LB660 which we passed last year and that is what my amendment is trying to do. If he was going to remove section two then we would not have needed it. Now we have got to conform with 660 which we passed and a 60 year of age which is the federal a law and the one we passed last year, giving these local authorities the things that they need to do. To allow the equipment to be used and everything else. But we have a conflict if we pass it on.

SPEAKER: You have a right to submit the amendment, do you want to or not?

SENATOR BARNETT: I was trying to ask Senator Snyder, I don't know what he wanted to hold it up for.

SENATOR SNYDER: Well we will kill it tomorrow anyway, lets go ahead.

SPEAKER: Fine, Senator Barnett.

SENATOR BARNETT: I would ask that the amendment that I had offered on page 591 is brought back in.
