

CLERK: Mr. President, the motion is to return LB1028 to Select File for specific amendment. Signed, Senator Waldron.

SENATOR WALDRON: Mr. President, this is the other amendment to LB1028 we spoke of earlier and I move that it be returned to Select File for this specific amendment. It appears on...the amendment appears on page 778 in the Legislative Journal and it's listed as under LB326 and that's...I thought the bill drafter had put these two together but he had not. And so we took LB326 and placed it in LB1028.....

PRESIDENT: Senator Waldron, is this the amendment that you and Senator Murphy agreed upon?

SENATOR WALDRON: Yes, it is.

PRESIDENT: Anybody want to speak on it? All right, all in favor of returning this LB1028 to Select File for a specific amendment vote aye. Those opposed vote no. Requires 25 votes. Have you all voted? Senator Waldron is preparing to ask for a Call of the House so I'm going to leave it open for a couple of minutes. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries and now Senator Waldron.

SENATOR WALDRON: Mr. President, I move the amendment be adopted.

PRESIDENT: The motion's been made that the amendment be adopted. Are there any further discussions? All those in favor of adopting the amendment vote aye. Those opposed vote no. Requires 25 votes. Motion to adopt the Waldron amendment. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 9 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Amendment's adopted. Now, Senator Waldron.

SENATOR WALDRON: Mr. President, I move the bill be advanced to E & R for Engrossment.

PRESIDENT: You've heard the motion. Are you ready for the question? All those in favor of advancing the bill, say aye. Those opposed no. Bill's advanced as amended. Clerk.

CLERK: Okay, Mr. President, I move to return LB1054 to Select File for a specific amendment. This specific amendment is to add the severability clause, signed, Senator Carpenter.
