SENATOR KEYES: When I look at Chancellor Varner and Chancellor Zumberge, I take one look and I decide these budding vocational technical schools with the overhang of the University of Nebraska at Omaha would probably not come into existence the way the voc-tech people have combined for them so I would say I don't want them telling me how to build a voc-tech school.

SENATOR GOODRICH: Well, for that reason then, I'd have to oppose your amendment unless you're willing to strike that clause. We've got to leave that in or I can't support the amendment, I'm sorry.

SENATOR KEYES: Senator Goodrich, that becomes your prerogative. I never try to tell you what to do.

PRESIDENT: All right, Senator Keyes is closing. You want to close, Senator Keyes?

SENATOR KEYES: I've already closed.

PRESIDENT: All right, the question is, whether or not to adopt the Keyes amendment to LB1057. All those in favor vote aye. Those opposed vote no. Now, have you all voted? The Chair's been asked what this is all about. This is the Keyes amendment to LB1057 which is as I understand it would specify the three geographical areas in which campuses are to be built on the metropolitan voc-tech school. Have I explained that correctly, Senator Keyes. Now you can't argue the bill, you can tell him what it does.

SENATOR KEYES: No, you have explained it exactly right. Senator Proud.

PRESIDENT: Clerk will record.

CLERK: 15-15, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion lost. Further amendments, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, an amendment offered by Senator Carpenter as follows. On page 13, line, insert...(Clerk read amendment found on page 1455 of Journal).

SENATOR CARPENTER: Mr. President, this is the exact language that was put in the appropriation bill pertaining to the University of Nebraska and the Normal Schools. It only applies the same provision in the technical schools. I move for its adoption.

PRESIDENT: Any discussion of this amendment? All those in favor of the Carpenter amendment vote aye. Those opposed vote no. Requires 25 votes for its adoption. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, no nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The Carpenter amendment is adopted. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, another amendment by Senator Marvel. To add a severability clause.

PRESIDENT: Senator Marvel. Senator Marvel has proposed an amendment to adopt the severability clause. Any discussion? All those in favor of adopting the severability clause to
