SENATOR LUEDTKE: Well, I misunderstood then because that's what the...the press carried the story that the recommendation was that this...that this be what your committee do. And your committee did not accept the staff's recommendation.

SENATOR STAHMER: Well, I think.....

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Not that that's unusual about any committee. We don't always accept recommendations of staff anyway.

SENATOR STAHMER: No, if I'm wrong, I stand to be corrected. I think Mr. Ehrlich does not disapprove of additional planning on a statewide basis and if I'm wrong, I stand to be corrected. I think you asked him to draft him an amendment to take the money you wanted to do for a study of the state. You're subverting that now into building a building. I don't think this or our staff recommended this and our committee was unanimous in its decision with backing of the staff. And if I'm wrong, I'll stand to be corrected. But I would like to ask you if you could pass over this and let somebody else bring up an amendment until we have time to read it, we just now got a copy of it.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Well, Mr. President, I ask if Senator Marvel will yield to a question before I decide to do that.

PRESIDENT: Senator Marvel.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Senator Marvel, along the same line asking you is it now true in an attempt to get the Judiciary Committee and the Appropriations Committee together and we have been discussing this together, first of all, haven't we been discussing this together since last summer? This particular problem? We have had many conferences, you and I and our staff, isn't that correct?

SENATOR MARVEL: Yes.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: And this is nothing new. This particular thing is not something new that I just dreamed up, isn't that true?

SENATOR MARVEL: No, we've had a number of conferences. Now if you're going to ask me the question as to whether the staff approves this recommendation or not, I would have to defer comment on that until I visit with the staff. It's true that we have had a number of discussions. It's also true that your committee.....
