PRESIDENT: Senator Whitney has moved for the advancement of the bill as amended. Any discussion? All those in favor of advancing the bill vote aye, those opposed vote no. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, no nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced. LB913. Clerk will read.

CLERK: LB913 (read) There is an amendment offered by Senator Fred Carstens, Banking committee.

PRESIDENT: Senator Carstens.

SENATOR CARSTENS: I move the amendment be adopted. All these committee amendments were, when the bill was up for hearing there were some words omitted. And this is all it does. Is to add in and insert a line which was inadvertently omitted to clear up this bill. It does not change the bills substance in any other way.

PRESIDENT: Is this a committee amendment.

SENATOR CARSTENS: Yes.

PRESIDENT: Senator Carpenter. Senator Carpenter passes. Are you ready for the question. The question is the adoption of the committee amendment. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. This requires 25 votes. If you are going to vote, please vote. Otherwise you just hold up the entire procedure. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes 0 nays.

PRESIDENT: Amendment is adopted. Are there other amendments.

CLERK: None.

PRESIDENT: All right, are you ready to advance the bill. Is there any discussion. Senator Whitney. All right, the motion is to advance the bill. All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed Senator Johnson, were you asking for the floor? All those in favor vote aye, all those opposed vote no. It requires 25 votes. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced. LB1048

CLERK: LB 1048 (read) There amendments offered by Senator Marsh which are found in full in the legislative journal on page 1271.

PRESIDENT: Senator Marsh.

SENATOR MARSH: I move for the adoption of the amendment. This is a committee amendment. The amendments are needed to clarify the intent of LB1048 and to insure compatibility with the constitution.
