

(Start Belt #11A)

CLERK: 15 ayes, 16 nays.

SPEAKER: Chair is sustained, Senator Luedtke.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Mr. President....

CLERK: What about the Emergency Clause, did you order that adopted?

SPEAKER: Lets vote on it. All of those in favor of adding the Emergency Clause vote aye, those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? This is the amendment to the bill, right Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Yes.

SPEAKER: Clerk will record.

CLERK: 14 ayes, 17 nays.

SPEAKER: Emergency clause is not added.

CLERK: Read motion to indefinitely postpone, signed Senator Mahoney.

SPEAKER: Senator Mahoney.

SENATOR MAHONEY: Mr. President, I don't see that this bill is such a great emergency. It came out of the Judiciary Committee and we know what comes out of the Judiciary Committee. So let me just say this, that since it is my underlined bill and I'll answer your question for you Senator Luedtke, I didn't ask for this bill, I don't want this bill, take this bill away. SPEAKER: Time is expired, all those in favor of indefinitely postponement vote aye, those opposed vote no. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 7 nays...

SPEAKER: Senator Luedtke.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Point a personal privilege. Since the Judiciary committee never even got a chance to present this bill, I would just like to say this. The Judiciary Committee never asked Senator Mahoney to underline this bill. I don't know who did, but that is his business and not mine, but I did not ask him, but once underlined I felt that we should defend the action of the committee which I did not get a chance to do, but let it go.
