

which Senator Luedtke has added to this bill which will repeal another bill which conflicted with the one that was vetoed. So I am asking that you would advance...Oh, first of all, I ask that you adopt the amendments to LB705.

SPEAKER: Are these committee amendment Senator Chambers?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes.

SPEAKER: Fine, Senator Stahmer. Senator Stahmer, passes, Senator F. Carstens, Senator Carstens passes. Senator Syas.

SENATOR SYAS: I just want to say to Senator Chambers, that I support his bill, but speaking from the heart, I wish he would be in here when the rest of us have our bills up, so he could vote and help us. He comes in just on his own bills and then you don't see him for awhile and I think that it is wrong...

SPEAKER: We are not going into any personal discussions. That is his business. Anyone else want to speak on this bill. The motion is to adopt the committee amendments. Are you ready for the question? Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DE CAMP: Pass.

SPEAKER: All those in favor of adopting the committee amendments vote aye, those opposed vote no. This requires 25 votes. Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, Mr. President.

SPEAKER: Committee amendments are adopted. Any further amendments?

CLERK: Read Luedtke amendment.

SPEAKER: Well what is the amendment Senator Luedtke?

SENATOR LUEDTKE: The amendment is what Senator Chambers has just explained. It was made necessary by the veto of LB647 which neglected to repeal a section 24-339 of the 1972 laws passed by this legislature concerning court reporters, and this takes care of it in this bill. It is just a repealer which we overrode the Governor's veto on the basis that we would include this in this bill.

SPEAKER: Senator F. Carstens, are you asking for the floor? Fine, Senator DeCamp?

SENATOR DE CAMP: Mr. President, the bill is unconstitutional. The bill contrary to the opinion that Senator Chambers handed around the other day, which would give you...

SPEAKER: Excuse me Senator DeCamp. Are you talking on the Luedtke amendment? If you want to talk on the constitutionality of the bill in general you will have your chance, but we are now on the Luedtke amendment. Alright, the question is shall the Luedtke amendment be adopted? All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. This requires 25 votes. If you are going to vote please vote, it will save a call of the house. I'm going to record the vote Senator Luedtke, what do you want to do? Clerk will record.
