CLERK: LB923.

PRESIDENT: Wait a minute, we have to move LB1026.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: I move LB1026 be advanced to E & R for Engrossing.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to advance LB1026 as amended. All those in favor of the advancement of the bill please say aye. Those opposed say no. LB1026 is advanced.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: I move the adoption of E & R amendments to LB923.

PRESIDENT: The motion now is to adopt the amendments to LB923. All those in favor of that motion say aye. Those opposed say no. The amendments to LB923 are adopted. You'll have to be faster than that, Senator.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: (Inaudible). ...be advanced to E & R for Engrossing...

PRESIDENT: Now, there's a motion to advance LB923. All those in favor of the advancement of the bill please say aye. Those opposed say no. The bill is advanced. Now we are privileged this morning to have 37 Kountze Memorial Church youth group here, 37 members of the Kountze Memorial Church youth group here from Omaha, Nebraska. Seated in the north balcony.
