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lot of our responsibility to the Board of Educational Lands and Funds. The increasing of the rental fee by the board has been accomplished whether it was entirely fair or not in all instances. Only time will tell. But I believe this body then would have to accept the responsibility to further make this land to the utmost of it's capacity to yield and then to return the proper return for the school children of the state. I do believe, as I have for many years that this land should be offered for sale if and when under certain conditions that the Legislature has imposed. But even then, if the land is sold it is of a much higher value because it can produce. If it is not sold, that land would not quality, and the time isn't apparent at this time, or isn't up for a lease and should not be sold, then of course we would have a greater return. I can see nothing wrong with trying to multiply the dollars received from this land, and consequently we would need this bill and especially this amendment at this time.

PRESIDENT: Next to speak is Senator Whitney Richard Lewis, Stull, More, Duis.

SENATOR WHITNEY: Mr. President, before I speak I would like to ask Senator DeCamp a question.

PRESIDENT: Senator DeCamp yield.

SENATOR DECAMP: Yes, Sir.

SENATOR WHITNEY: Well, Senator DeCamp what your doing is striking my amendmet to sections 6?

SENATOR DECAMP: I believe that is the section, yes, Sir. The one dealing with improvements.

CLERK: The amendment page strikes all of the Whitney amendment. Is it just limited to section 6?

SENATOR DECAMP: No, just striking the Whitney amendment to Section 6 is all I want. I don't want to strike the rest of his amendment. It was perfectly good and proper and needs to be in there.

SENATOR WHITNEY: O.K. now then, this section 6 now reads, the cost of administering unsold school lands shall include expenses required to maintain...no capital expenditures to developing school lands to their highest best use. All expenditures shall be directed to the board in exercising it's responsibility as a trustee over this school land trust and shall not exceed 30% of all rentals, and bonus payment of the previous year, which amounts shall be set aside in the State Treasure for use in the following year. Now, will that still be in there like that, Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DECAMP: Yes, the appropriation in there is only for 10% not 30. If you want to change the 30 to 10 I have no objection.

SENATOR WHITNEY: Well, it could go up to 30% though according to..

SENATOR DECAMP: They could not go any higher than this Legislature allowed them to. And that 30% is obsolete anyway. The committee changed it to 20. And I changed it to 10, in the appropriation.
