I couldn't believe it so I checked with the Attorney General and he checked it out and wrote an opinion saying yes, that is the case, so all this does is give the liquor commission the authority also to check on unlicensed premises.

PRESIDENT: Senator Carpenter.

SENATOR CARPENTER: This is the same amendment that this body adopted on I think it was 616. The Commission is of the opinion as I recall and understand that under the present law that they do not have the right, even though there was a question to it, of going in and to attempt to discontinue the sale of these products by those who do not have a license. This amendment does two things, number one it give the commission the right to do it and so far as I am concerned it gives them also the direction to do it and I think that the amendment ought to be adopted.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion of the motion? Senator DeCamp do you have any closing? Question is do you want to adopt the DeCamp amendment, if you do vote aye, if not vote no. Motion is to adopt the DeCamp amendment, to 681. Thank you, Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays.

PRESIDENT: Amendment is adopted. Are there other amendments to the bill? Any further amendments? Are there other amendments now to the bill? Thank you. What is your pleasure gentlemen. Senator Marsh.

SENATOR MARSH: I move the bill be advanced.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to advance LB681. All those in favor of advancing the bill vote aye, those opposed vote no. Motion is to advance 681 as amended. Advancing 681 as amended. Have you all voted? Motion is to advance 681. Thank you, Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 2 nays.

PRESIDENT: Bill is advanced. This brings up for Select File 677.

PRESIDENT: Senator Cavanaugh we have E & R amendments to 677.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Move the adoption of the amendments.
