

SENATOR CARPANETER: It doesn't cover anyone that is expiring to a federal office?

SENATOR KELLY: No sir, it would be a candidate for state offices named in the constitution.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion of the Cavanaugh amendment? Senator Cavanaugh do you have closing?

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: I would just close by saying that I think that you are delegating an extremely important power and potentially campaign tool and that we should try and build into this act every assurance that it is going to be administered fairly and partially and not manipulate to abuse a political process but to strengthen the integrity of the political process that Senator Kelly has intended.

PRESIDENT: Well, Senator Kelly. I assumed that he was closing.

SENATOR KELLY: Well that is fine, I just wanted to say that I do support Senator Cavanaugh's...

PRESIDENT: Thank you. Question is do you want to adopt the Cavanaugh amendment to LB677. If you do vote aye, if not vote no. Motion is to adopt the Cavanaugh amendment to 677. Voting on the Cavanaugh amendment to 677 on Select File. Have you all voted?

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: I'll probably have to ask for a call of the house.

PRESIDENT: Alright. Once again have you all voted?

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: A call of the house.

PRESIDENT: Senator Cavanaugh is asking for a call of the house. Thank you. Motion is to have a call of the house. Senator Cavanaugh is asking for a call of the house. Once again, have you all voted? Motion is for a call of the house. Alright, Clerk will record.

CLERK: 17 ayes, 0 nays.

PRESIDENT: We are under a call of the house. The next bell please indicate your presence. Motion under vote is the Cavanaugh amendment. 677 on Select File. Would you please all indicate your presence, lets at least get that done. There has got to be more than 28 of you here. That is all that I am asking you to do. Motion under vote is the Cavanaugh amendment to 677 on Select File. OK, thank you. Clerk will record.

CLERK: That was just roll call.

PRESIDENT: That is right. We have a motion to raise the call. All those in favor of raising the call vote aye, those opposed vote no. Motion is to raise the call. Alright, Clerk will record.

CLERK: 32 ayes, to raise the call.

PRESIDENT: Call is raised, read the tally on the original vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 10 nays and 13 not voting.
