

SENATOR WHITNEY: F. B. Thompson has been appointed to the Board of Public Roads, classification standards. R. Gilmore to the oil and gas conservation commission. John Mason to the oil and gas conservation commission. John Shoemaker, power review board. John Sullivan Agricultural Products Utilization Committee. Gary Shults Ag. Products Utilization Committee. CLERK: Mr...Senator Whitney, how about Holly Hodge?

SENATOR WHITNEY: Pardon?

CLERK: How about Holly Holdge on page 1414?

SENATOR WHITNEY: Holl Holdge also on Ag. Products Industrialization Utilization committee. I move that the Legislature accept all of these men and no one appeared against any one of these persons.
