

CLERK: I don't think that it does anything. The Constitution says that you have 30 votes to appropriate in excess of the Governors request and if you don't have 30 votes you can or he can sign it and it still has no effect.

PRESIDENT: Senator Snyder.

SENATOR SNYDER: Mr. President, as a matter of clarification may I ask the Chair a question?

PRESIDENT: Certainly.

SENATOR SNYDER: Is it proper then or would it be proper later today for a move to reconsider?

PRESIDENT: Yes sir. It has to be done before that moves to the Governor but these bills....I think that it is the Chairs understanding that these bills this afternoon are not under suspension of the rules for expediting to the Governor. Are they? Oh, I'm sorry there was another motion then.

SENATOR SNYDER: Therefore I would ask unanimous consent that LB875A be held here in the body.

PRESIDENT: Senator Snyder is asking unanimous consent to hold LB87A in the body.

SENATOR SNYDER: Lets make it a joint proposition 875 and 875A.

PRESIDENT: Now then, are there objections to holding the bills here? ARE there any objections? Senator Chambers are you objecting? This is a unanimous consent motion. Don't be putting me in a spot here, are there objections? Hearing none then, the bills will be held. Senator Chambers did you want the floor?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, I would like to move for reconsideration of LB875A, and I did not vote so I am in a position to move for the reconsideration.

PRESIDENT: Senator Chabmers has asked for a reconsideration of the vote on LB875A. Now do you want to debate the issue? Senator Savage did you want to be heard on the issue?

SENATOR SAVAGE: I want to make the same motion.

PRESIDENT: Alright, any further discussion? Question is do you want to reconsider your action? If you do vote aye, Senator Murphy.

SENATOR MURPHY: Mr. President, 875 provides these various levies and authorities for transit authorities and cities but the funding bill of one million dollars applies only to transit authorities, am I wrong in my reading on that?

PRESIDENT: Chair can't interpret that for you, and not on Final Reading.

SENATOR MURPHY: I think that it is important in reconsideration that this million dollars will go only the transit authority and not the cities.
