PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Stahmer.

SENATOR STAHMER: Mr. President, members, very quickly there was some misunderstanding I believe on the motion on hearing bills today and these are two bills held over from last year and I would like to have the Governor have a chance at them one way or another. That is why I make that unanimous consent.

PRESIDENT: Are there objections to hearing 94 and 302 next in that order? Any objections? Hearing none, we will take up 94 next.

CLERK: Read LB94

PRESIDENT: State your point Senator.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Members of the Legislature, I have talked to you a lot about 932 and 933 and over the night I have thought about it and I think I have detected what I seem to believe is a serious problem. So I have drafted a letter which I hope that you will take the time to read and not throw away, because I'm going to try and bring those bills back and kill them if I can and the bulk of the argument will be contained in that letter and I know that they will come up at the tail end of the day so this could save time if you would at least scan it and be aware of what the objections are. Thank you.

PRESIDENT: Attention please Final Reading of 780

CLERK: Read LB780.

PRESIDENT: While all provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, "Shall the bill pass?". All those in favor vote aye, those opposed vote no. Once again, have you all voted? Once again are you all through voting. Clerk....Senator Fellman.

SENATOR FELLMAN: Could I have a roll call vote?

PRESIDENT: Sure, Senator Fellman asking for a roll call vote.

CLERK: Roll call vote taken. 20 ayes, 26 nays and 3 not voting. Vote appears on page 1642 of the Legislative Journal.
