PRESIDENT: Please indicate your presence. Clerk will record.

CLERK: A quorum, Mr. President, is not present.

PRESIDENT: We will stand by at ease for a few moments. We have 23, Senator. Twenty-five, I believe in this Body to constitute a quorum. Will the Legislature please come to order. We'll have Roll Call once again. I need 25 people on the floor, Senator Maresh. Clerk will record.

CLERK: A quorum is present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: All right, we'll continue Final Reading then. The reading of LB1048. Clerk will read the bill. We would remind the senators that we're on Final Reading. The floor will be clear. The substitute clerk will read the bill. Attention please, the Final Reading of LB1048, loud and clear.

CLERK: Read LB1048.

SENATOR R. LEWIS: Mr. Speaker, Senator Goodrich was called out of the room and he asked me to vote for him which I declined to do but I know he wants to vote aye.

PRESIDENT: Go ahead, it's fine and dandy. Once again, the Chair wants to inquire if you have all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: Read record vote. 45 ayes, 0 nays, 4 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The bill is passed with the emergency clause attached. Attention please, the Final Reading of LB632.

CLERK: Mr. President, we have some reports.

PRESIDENT: Do you want to read these reports?

CLERK: Mr. President, your Committee on Enrollment and Review reports, we have examined and reviewed LB937 and find the same correctly enrolled. LB938 correctly enrolled. LB969 correctly enrolled. LB982 correctly enrolled. LB923 correctly enrolled. LB934 correctly enrolled. LB935 correctly enrolled. LB1002 correctly enrolled. LB1026 correctly enrolled. LB1029 correctly enrolled. Signed, John Cavanaugh, chairman.

PRESIDENT: Let the record show that while the Legislature was in session and capable of transacting business, I have signed LB937, 938, 969, 982, 923, 934, subsequent thereto, 935, 1002, 1026 and in conclusion LB1029. Clerk will continue with the Final Reading of LB632.

CLERK: Read LB632.

PRESIDENT: All provision of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall the bill pass? All those in favor vote aye. All those opposed vote no. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

PRESIDENT: Senator Kennedy voting aye.

CLERK: Read record vote. (See page 1661 of Journal). 47 ayes, 0 nays, 2 not voting.
