## LEGISLATIVE BILL 252

Approved by the Governor April 28, 1975

Introduced by Rasmussen, 41

AN ACT to amend section 39-677, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, relating to Nebraska Rules of the Road; to provide what shall constitute overloading of the front seat or obstructing the driver's view; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 39-677, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

39-677. (1) No person shall drive a motor vehicle when it is so loaded, or when there are is in the front seat more—than—three—persons—over—the—age—of twelver—or—when—it—is—so-loaded—with—either—persons—or articles such a number of persons, exceeding three, as to obstruct the view of the driver to the front or sides of the vehicle or to interfere with the driver's control over the driving mechanism of such vehicle.

(2) No passenger in a vehicle shall ride in such a position as to interfere with the driver's view ahead or to the sides or to interfere with the driver's control over the driving mechanism of such vehicle.

Sec. 2. That original section 39-677, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
