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started or has the Pharmacy College been started? Well, there is two ways you can look at it. The money has been spent for the Pharmacy Colleges. Has it not already been started. That's my first question. My second question will follow his answer.

SENATOR CARSTEN: If I may use your microphone, sir. This is one of the reasons that I think that the Appropriations Committee should give us some answers. I am assuming--

PRESIDENT: Answer the question, Senator Carsten. Is this one or is it not?

SENATOR CARSTEN: Is it not what, sir?

PRESIDENT: Is this one of the projects that has been started or is it not one of the projects that have been started.

SENATOR CARSTEN: I am assuming from what Senator Marvel said it has been started.

SENATOR SYAS: OK. Second question. If it has been started, Senator, then the second question is then this here motion doesn't apply to the Pharmacy College, right?

SENATOR CARSTEN: I would say that it didn't because I'm including all capital construction that has not been started.

PRESIDENT: Senator Marvel, for what purpose do you arise?

SENATOR MARVEL: I would like to ask Senator Carsten--try to phrase a question.

PRESIDENT: Will you yield to a question from Senator Marvel?

SENATOR MARVEL: Senator Carsten, would you consider withdrawing your motion so that our Committee can proceed to come in with a report which is not tied to the Governor's request. The Governor's request is set up to put us on a spot and I am not interested in that and in this I agree with Senator Chambers. So would you consider withdrawing your motion so that we can proceed to do what we would be doing anyway which will satisfy you?

SENATOR CARSTEN: Mr. President, can I answer his question with a question.

PRESIDENT: That's not proper. Answer the question whether you want to withdraw--

SENATOR CARSTEN: Yes.

PRESIDENT: Do you now withdraw your motion?

SENATOR CARSTEN: Now, Mr. President, with unanimous consent of the body, I would ask that the motion be withdrawn, and then, Mr. President, may I have the opportunity of asking Senator Marvel a question that does relate to the subject.

PRESIDENT: All those in favor of granting unanimous consent signify by saying aye. Contrary. The motion was withdrawn.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have new bills and a motion to adjourn.

PRESIDENT: Senator Marvel's light--was that a previous light, Senator Marvel. Senator Carsten, for what purpose do you arise?

SENATOR CARSTEN: A point of information, Mr. President.
