PRESIDENT: Mr. Clerk, please excuse me. Chair recognizes Senator Burbach. Could we have a little order in the House please.

SENATOR BURBACH: Mr. President, I do have much to report, but the flowers have placed on your desk were there placed with my permission. We have a rule that nothing is placed on our desk unless it's initialed, but I gave the permission in this instance without initialing.
