us the only issue we should look at is strict conformity to the statutes, I want every member of the Legislature to see where the Committee was willing to allow the Attorney General's office to say that the Committee need not be bound by statute when its powers could be expanded thereby. But when the Attorney General made a statement about strictly complying with the statute which offered, maybe, a way out, then the Committee came back to the Legislature. This is why I'm asking that that particular transcript be copied and be given priority so that we can see the discussions on this particular issue between members of the Attorney General's office and the Committee and the failure of the Committee to take issue with the idea of picking and choosing statutes.

SPEAKER: The chair recognizes Senator Warner.

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I arise only to inform the Legislature as I indicated in our discussion sometime ago that copies of all the transcripts of all the Committee proceedings would be provided. It is in process at this point and not only will the 10th be provided to you but also each of the days and I have no objection. I don't remember the number of copies for the 10th we had left. There was 10 or 11, as I, 12 perhaps. No, not on the 10th, there were just 2 copies left in the file. These can be done first but, in any event, all of them, as I said, are to be provided so--

SPEAKER: Senator Warner. Senator Warner, you are offering no objection to the motion, then.

SENATOR WARNER: Of course not.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I would withdraw it in view of what he said, then. It is not even necessary. The motion is not necessary, then.

SPEAKER: (Mike not activated) the motion has been withdrawn. (Mike off) I have got it on, sir. Senator Chambers is withdrawing the motion because the Chairman of the Committee is recognized ~~that~~ he is planning to do this and he will do it without a motion. Senator Mahoney, would you sign this Reference Committee report so it will be legally documented.

CLERK: Mr. President, a Reference Committee report referring LB 357 through 477. It will be inserted in the file. Signed Senator Mahoney, Chairman. That's all I have, Mr. President. I move to adjourn until Monday at 10 o'clock. Signed Senator Barnett.
