be so stated in the Journal to start our Public Hearings of the Constitutional Revision and Recreation Committee at 1:30 p.m. Therefore, I ask unanimous consent of the Legislature to do that. I understand this is the way it has to be handled under the rules.

PRESIDENT: Are there any objections? Seeing none, there is unanimous consent to Senator Syas. Senator Dworak.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the amendment to LB 36.

PRESIDENT: The chair recognizes Senator Dworak.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, I move the adoption of LB--of the amendment to LB 36.

PRESIDENT: Does anyone wish to be heard on the amendment? This is a machine vote. Voice vote on an amendment? We think it does require 25 and the only way to determine that is a machine vote. So, the question is shall the amendment to LB 36 pass. Record your vote. Have you voted? Record your vote.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, 20 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, I move that LB 36 be advanced to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT: Any discussion? Record your vote. Have you voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: LB 36 as amended shall be so advanced. Senator Barnett, for what purpose do you arise?

SENATOR BARNETT: Mr. President, a question of the chair on procedure. Was this just on this last bill because it was amended that we have a machine vote or do we move the bills on Select File on voice vote.

PRESIDENT: I am not that familiar, Senator Barnett. I inquired of the Clerk and he is sort of the opinion that it does require 25 votes.

SENATOR BARNETT: To move any bill off Select, right?

PRESIDENT: And to adopt any amendment on Select.

SENATOR BARNETT: I thought--the amendment I might agree to but I was checking on Select File and just a question as to whether--we might have been used to doing it this way and I'm not saying it's right, I am just asking for a clarification from the chair because I think there is some confusion.

PRESIDENT: So you are talking about moving it off Select to E & R Final.

SENATOR BARNETT: Right. Could be a voice vote.

PRESIDENT: You could be right, Senator. I think we'll take a look at it.
