PRESIDENT: You're the last speaker on the board. Do you care to close? We can have a vote on it, but there's nobody else asking to speak and so it's time . . . There is one other light. You are moving that debate cease. Are there five seconds showing? The Chair rules that there are. The question is, shall debate cease. Record your vote. Have you voted? Record Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 17 nays, 3 not voting.

PRESIDENT: Debate shall cease. Senator Warner do you care to reply or close?

SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I -- no I will not. I think the issue has been well covered, additional closing is not necessary. I've stated and restated the question as I believe it is before the Legislature. It certainly has been adequately discussed.

PRESIDENT: For what purpose do you arise, Senator Schmit?

SENATOR SCHMIT: For the purpose of asking a question of Senator Warner, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Direct the question to the Chair, Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, I would like to ask Senator Warner if he is aware of the fact that a bond for one million dollars has been filed with the Clerk of the District Court in Scotts Bluff through the Fidelity Insurance Company to cover all cost of the contested election?

PRESIDENT: Chair rules that question out of order, Senator Schmit. The question is, the adoption of the Warner motion, shall the Warner motion pass. I think it has to be done in individual votes, but the Chair does recognize your request. There has been a request that a roll call or record vote be taken. The question again is, shall the Warner motion be adopted. Call the roll Mr. Clerk.
