CLERK: 40 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to introduce.

PRESIDENT: The bill is introduced.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next motion is I move the introduction of the attached bill. Signed Senator Marvel. It is request #709. It is a bill appropriating monies for deficiencies of state government. Signed Senator Marvel.

PRESIDENT: The chair recognizes Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: I move that the bill be introduced and I'd like to explain it. You have a sheet on your desk someplace that indicates that this bill, if you approve and then approve the next motion to put it on General File and let it sit there until it is printed and until you have a chance to look at it, would allow a deficiency appropriation of 8.5 million dollars roughly. Almost 6 million dollars of this is due to the Supreme Court decision in regard to Vocational-Technical Education and we have to make up at least this much money at the moment and the one Voc-Tech school that is in trouble and the reason that this is an emergency situation is the Metro in Omaha and the next largest amount is 2.6 million dollars which goes to the Department of Revenue to make up a deficiency in the area of Homestead Exemption. So the total figure is roughly 8.5 million dollars and all I am asking is that the bill be introduced and then the motion would be that it be placed on General File and it remain there until it's printed and the Legislature has a chance to look at it.

PRESIDENT: Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. Speaker, a question of Senator Marvel, if he would, please.

SENATOR MARVEL: Yes sir.

SENATOR KOCH: Senator Marvel, what's the condition of the deficit appropriation for the schools as it relates to 403.

SENATOR MARVEL: We are suppose to take that up today.

SENATOR KOCH: Thank you.

SENATOR MARVEL: The reason I would kind of like to get this one in now is, basically, the area that's in trouble, the Voc-Tech's school.

PRESIDENT: The question is Senator Marvel's motion for request #709 for the introduction of a deficit appropriation bill. It is a machine vote. It requires 30 votes. Record your vote. Have you voted. Record the vote.

CLERK: 42 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The bill is introduced.

CLERK: The reading of new bills by title. LB 535. LB 536. LB 537. LB 538. Mr. President, a motion on the desk. I move to suspend the rules and place LB 537 directly on General File. Signed Senator Marvel.

PRESIDENT: Could we have a specific reference to the rule, please?
