CLERK: Rule 6. It would be Rule 3, Section 5, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Marvel. Senator Duis, excuse me.

SENATOR DUIS: May I make a suggestion. My suggestion would be to allow the bill to go to the Reference Committee and be referred to their Committee and then have them put it on General File. Then suspend the Rule of the five day bracketing. I think it will be a lot simpler and you will find that Rule to be very specific.

CLERK: It takes a couple of days to do it, though, Herb.

SENATOR DUIS: Fine. Go ahead and try it the other way. OK.

SENATOR MARVEL: It doesn't make any difference to me which way we do it. We have had the hearing on the bill. If you want to go that route, that's fine. Do you want to do that, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: It's faster this way.

SENATOR MARVEL: Which way.

CLERK: The way your motion now is.

SENATOR MARVEL: Well, all I am trying to do now is to see that the bill is printed, the Legislature get a copy of it so they can take a look at it and then, if they approve it, we can get it on the way so that the Voc-Tech schools can get their 5.9 million dollars. That's all.

CLERK: You had better go this motion, then.

SENATOR MARVEL: Ok.

PRESIDENT: There is a motion by Senator Marvel to suspend Section 5 of Rule 3 with regard to LB 537. This is a machine vote. It requires 30 votes. Is there any further discussion on the question of the suspension of the Rules. Record your vote. Have you voted? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 37 ayes, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The rules are suspended. The chair recognizes Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: Vince, what's the next motion.

CLERK: That's all.

SENATOR MARVEL: OK, then the bill is automatically on General File. OK.

CLERK: That's all, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Consideration of bills on Select File. The chair recognizes Senator Dworak.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the amendments to LB 1.

PRESIDENT: Is there any discussion? The question is shall the amendments to LB 1 be adopted. All those in favor signify by saying aye. Contrary. The amendments are adopted.
