SENATOR DUIS: Mr. President, a hypothetical . . . say we're in the Hiram Scott issue which we were last year, if this is the case then could Scotts Bluff request to have the hearing out at Scotts Bluff instead of here in the Capitol Building?

PRESIDENT: That's a continuation of the debate, Senator, over the motion rather than a request for specific information and it is hypothetical. Record your vote. Have you voted? Record.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 4 nays, 13 not voting Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries.

CLERK: Mr. President, your committee on Public Works to whom was referred LB 60 instructs me to report the same to the Legislature with the recommendation that it be advanced to General File as amended; LB 62 General File as amended; LB 104 General File as amended. Signed, Senator Kremer, Chairman.

Mr. President, the Retirement Committee will hold Retirement Executive Session today at noon. Signed, Senator Hasebroock.

Mr. President, unanimous consent to bracket LB 82 on E & R for engrossing. Signed, Senator Dworak.

Mr. President, I move we adjourn. Signed, Senator Burbach.

PRESIDENT: Senator Lewis, you have . . . your voting machine doesn't work?

SENATOR F. LEWIS: My machine doesn't work and I wanted to be counted as a yes vote on the last issue.

PRESIDENT: Alright. There is a motion to adjourn. Senator Koch, for what purpose do you arise?

SENATOR KOCH: Have the Clerk repeat that last motion to bracket.

CLERK: Mr. President, unanimous consent to bracket LB 82 on E & R for engrossing. Signed, Senator Dworak.

SENATOR KOCH: I object.

PRESIDENT: There is no unanimous consent on the request to bracket LB 82.

CLERK: Mr. President, I move to bracket LB 82 on E & R for engrossing. Signed, Senator Dworak.

PRESIDENT: That's out of order there is a motion to adjourn. Or, was that before the motion to adjourn? I don't think we can take that then, because the motion to adjourn came prior to the motion to bracket. The motion is to adjourn. All in favor signify by saying aye. We are adjourned.
