SENATOR LUEDTKE: Yes, it was Senator Lewis.

SENATOR R. LEWIS: They are now uniform?

SENATOR LUEDTKE: They are now uniform.

SENATOR R. LEWIS: Thank you.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: If we pass this bill.

CLERK: Mr. President, a motion on the desk.

PRESIDENT: Proceed.

CLERK: I move on page 2, line 26 to strike the word "and"; page 2 strike line 27; page 3 strike lines 1, 2, and 3. Signed, Senator Cavanaugh. Is this to the committee amendment or to the bill? I'm sorry Mr. President, wrong bill, this was just handed to me.

PRESIDENT: If there's no further discussion are you ready for the question? Question is, shall LB 196, as amended, advance to E & R initial. Record your vote. Have you voted? Record Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 1 nay.

PRESIDENT: LB . . . motion carries. LB 196 is advanced to E & R initial. We're now on General File for LB 165.

CLERK: Read bill.

PRESIDENT: Senator Kennedy.

SENATOR KENNEDY: Mr. President, fellow members, I move for the adoption of the amendment. It's a very simple amendment. On page 2, line 18 after "facility" insert "licensed as such". It just happened to be omitted at the time. I move for the adoption of this amendment.

PRESIDENT: Is there any discussion on the motion? The question is the adoption of the committee amendments. Record your vote. Record Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries. The amendments are adopted. Alright, Senator Dworak.

SENATOR DWORAK: This bill affects the residency requirements for collecting welfare. The Legislatures intent, when they originally passed this law, was to exclude people who moved from one county to another as a patient in a care home, or nursing home, licensed by the Department of Health. Since the passage of this law a new entity was created and termed a "licensed board and room home". In order to keep the same residency requirement intention for licensed board and room homes, as for licensed care homes and nursing homes, and to provide a law flexible to meet future needs, we wish to broaden the definition to any type of care homes.
