SENATOR DeCAMP: Mr. President, I move LB 145 be advanced to E & R for engrossing.

SPEAKER: Motion made and seconded to advance LB 145 to E & R for engrossing. All in favor indicate by the usual sign. Opposed. Motion carried.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Mr. President, I move LB 126 have the amendments, E & R amendments, adopted.

SPEAKER: Motion has been made and seconded for the E & R amendments to LB 126. Please indicate by vote if you are in favor or not. All in favor indicate by aye. Opposed. Same.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Mr. President, I move LB 126 be advanced to E & R for engrossing.

SPEAKER: Motion has been made and seconded to advance LB 126 to E & R for engrossment. All in favor indicate by the usual sign. Opposed. Motion carried.

We will now move to General File. LB 284.

CLERK: Read bill.

SPEAKER: Senator Luedtke.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the committee amendments to LB 284. The committee amendments clarify the wording of what kind of security can be filed . . . or additional security to be more specific, are to be filed with regard to the bail bond laws which we passed and changed last session. The courts were experiencing some difficulty with the wording "or other qualified security", because of the fact that they were coming in and asking for all kinds of things to be filed for other security. There was no definition or clarification. It was considered the best way to take care of it would be to strike that and make the security remain just what it was in the bill originally.

SPEAKER: Any further discussion? Seeing none, the question is shall the committee amendments be adopted? Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, Mr. President, on motion to adopt.

SPEAKER: Committee amendments are adopted. What do you want to do with the bill Senator Luedtke?

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Mr. President, I move that LB 284, as amended, be advanced to E & R initial. Mr. President, members of the Legislature, LB 284 as I indicated earlier in discussing the amendment deals with the bail bond procedures which we dealt with in LB 828 in the 1974 session of the Legislature. It specifically removes a conflict between LB 828 and Section 29-506, which you will note is the section which is amended in this bill,
