CLERK: It is request number 762 and it deals with the counties. To provide that county boards may exclude certain lands from a tax levy to cover the cost of garbage disposal.

SENATOR FOWLER: This bill relates to all counties. It would enable them to basically establish a special assessment for the collection of garbage. Right now they have the power to put a levy across the whole county for that. Some counties are finding that only certain portions of county utilize the service. This would enable them just to charge those particular municipalities for the service and not have to assess the total county. I move for its introduction.

SPEAKER: Is there any other discussion? The question is, shall request 762 be introduced. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on motion to introduce.

SPEAKER: By your action you have introduced request 762.

CLERK: Mr. President, I move for the introduction of the attached bill. Signed, Senator Anderson. It is a bill for an act relating to county jails. It's put in by the Miscellaneous Subjects Committee and signed by the members thereof. To provide that each county shall be reimbursed for boarding prisoners.

SPEAKER: Chair recognizes Senator Anderson.

SENATOR ANDERSON: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, this is a bill that, as it's written now, would primarily only affect Sarpe county. I'm told that Lancaster county has a city-county jail and would not directly be affected by the bill since they already have a different reimbursement system. It allows the reimbursement for actual cost of feeding and housing prisoners as opposed to the reimbursement fee to the sheriff. It was brought to us primarily at the request of the Sarpe County Board. The Miscellaneous Subjects Committee did vote for the introduction of the bill. I move its introduction.

SPEAKER: Any other discussion? The question is, shall the bill brought to us by the Miscellaneous Subjects Committee be introduced. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on motion to introduced.

SPEAKER: By your action you have introduced the Miscellaneous Subjects bill.
