SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the amendments to LB 290.

CLERK: Mr. President, a motion on the desk. I move to return LB 251 to Select File for specific amendment. The amendment is on page 2, line 6, strike "thirty-six" and insert "thirty". Then correct E & R amendment. Signed, Senator Marsh.

SENATOR MARSH: This is the amendment for the Nebraska Commission on the Status of Women who have asked to have the number of members moved from 36 to 30. At their request, I introduce this specific amendment. I would ask for your support to move this back to Select File for this purpose.

CLERK: Now, Mr. President, the motion would be for the adoption of the specific amendment. On page 2, line 6 strike "thirty-six" and insert "thirty" in the E & R amendment, correct. Signed, Senator Marsh.
