SENATOR STULL: First of all I guess I would move that we reconsider our action on . . .

PRESIDENT: You already have that motion on the floor. There is a motion by Senator Stull to reconsider the final vote on LB 2, which has not been signed by the Governor. Any further discussion? Record your vote. Have you voted? Record the vote.

CLERK: 38 ayes on motion to reconsider.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries, Senator Stull.

CLERK: Mr. President, I move that LB 2 be returned to E & R for engrossing for correlation with LB 186. Signed, Senator Stull.

PRESIDENT: Senator Stull.

SENATOR STULL: I would ask your support to this motion. LB 186 was an amendment to this same section. We need to bring it back so that we can correlate the two bills.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion on the question? Record your vote. Have you voted? Record the vote Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on motion to return to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries.

CLERK: Now Mr. President, we have a motion to return LB 45, the bill having been returned to us by the Governor. I move we reconsider our action on final passage of LB 45. Signed, Senator W. H. Hasebroock.

PRESIDENT: Senator Hasebroock.

SENATOR HASEBROOCK: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I move that we reconsider our actions so that we can correct an error that was found in the bill. We need to reconsider our action to do this and return it to Select File. I move that we reconsider our action.

PRESIDENT: Is there further discussion on the motion to reconsider? Record your vote. Record Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 36 ayes, 0 nays.

PRESIDENT: Senator Hasebroock.

SENATOR HASEBROOCK: I move . . .

CLERK: Now Mr. President, the motion is, I move to return LB 45 to Select File for specific amendment. Signed, Senator Hasebroock. The specific amendment is as follows: in the final reading bill, page 5, line 18, and in the title, line 8, strike "1974" and insert "1975".
