CLERK: Mr. President, your Enrolling Clerk reports that she did on this day at 8:50 present to the Governor for his approval LB 145, LB 60, LB 192A, LB 75. LB 62, LB 104, LB 192, LB 224 and LB 236. Signed, Barbara Jackson, Enrolling Clerk.

That's all Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Skarda, for what purpose do you arise?

SENATOR SKARDA: Permission to be excused Friday, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Seeing no objection, so ordered.

We will now go on Final Reading. The Chair requests that all non-senatorial personnel vacate the floor of the Legislature and ask that all Senators please assume their respective chairs. Mr. Clerk would you proceed with the Final Reading of LB 555.

CLERK: Motion on the desk Mr. President. Mr. President, I move to return 555 to Select File for specific amendment. Signed, Senator Marvel.

PRESIDENT: Read the specific amendment please.

CLERK: Mr. President, the amendments are set out in full on page 702 of the Legislative Journal.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Frank Lewis.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: Mr. Chairman, I'll wait until the motion has been presented by Senator Marvel then I wish to speak.

PRESIDENT: Would a Page . . . oh, I didn't see Senator Marvel. Chair recognizes Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: Is there a motion up there so I can speak to the motion?

PRESIDENT: Yes there is.

SENATOR MARVEL: First of all, I hope Senator Frank Lewis understands that the motion I made two days ago when he was gone was made prior to the knowledge that he had to be out of town. It had nothing to do with that. I have found, since those amendments have been put on, that they would take considerable amount of change in order to put into effect what I think I'm interested in. My purpose in standing up this morning, first of all, is to ask that the amendments be withdrawn so you can proceed to read 555. I would like to make one or two points. There have been many people working on these amendments, despite conversation to the contrary that they are offered by one or two people. There have been people that have come in from Hastings to work on these amendments. The fiscal staff has worked on them. We've received calls and help from people all over the state. LB 555 . . . well I better not violate the rules and talk about that. I think if you have time and will refer to Sections 3 through 8, at your leisure, you will find the philosophy encompassed in what these amendments are trying to do. I'd like to
