SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, may I ask a question now? The bill that's going to the Judiciary Committee is with the amendments that have been adopted today? Is that correct, or is it the bill that was introduced? I just don't know.

PRESIDENT: I think it would have to be with the amendments cause they've been adopted.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: OK. Could I ask you why I asked that? Because they want it for the purpose of a public hearing . . . never mind.

PRESIDENT: Senator Murphy, for what purpose do you arise?

SENATOR MURPHY: Subject to correction I would believe the committee can do as it wishes with the bill once it is returned. They could add, subtract, or invent new amendments.

CLERK: We'll return the bill in its current form with all the amendments attached. Then they can do with it what they want.

PRESIDENT: For what purpose do you arise, Senator Simpson?

SENATOR SIMPSON: Mr. President, I would also say if they have additional amendments people are considering putting on the bill that they take them to the committee, if they're going to have a hearing. Let's look at them all there and not have to send it back again.

PRESIDENT: Fine, thank you. The Chair failed when it acknowledged the students from Kearney State, in the North balcony, to also recognize that the professor of the class is Doctor Dale Mills, the Father of Senator Jack Mills. Welcome again. Senator Savage, the Chair recognizes for point of personal privilege.

SENATOR SAVAGE: I'd like to pass that for just a second until I introduce my bill if I may.

PRESIDENT: Alright. Senator Dworak.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the Enrollment and Review amendments to LB 152.

PRESIDENT: Any discussion? The question is the adoption of the amendments to LB 152. All in favor say aye. Contrary say nay. The amendments are adopted.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, I move that LB 152 be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: Any discussion? The question is the advancement of LB 152 as amended. All in favor say aye. Contrary say nay. The bill is so advanced.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the Enrollment and Review amendments to LB 200.
